2. **Declaration of Interest:** As per Register.
3. **Public Session**  
The Chairman invited questions from the members of the public present.  
There were no questions from those present.
4. **Discussions with Councillor A Eade and Mr V Brownlees**  
Councillors were asked to discuss issues in and around the parish with Councillor A Eade (Leader of Telford & Wrekin Council) and Mr V Brownlees (Chief Executive Telford & Wrekin Council). The following points/issues were raised:
  - Regeneration of District Centres
  - Allotments
  - Keep Left Bollards and Road Signs
  - Grant Applications by Groups employed by T&Wr
  - Roads and Footpaths
  - Community Fund
  - Planning Issues especially those concerning the former site of the Champion Jockey Public House
  - Parking at the Library Donnington
  - Switching off street lighting
  - Arriva proposed new bus routes
  - Delivery lorries parking on road at Asda Donnington and traffic lights for junction of Donnington Wood Way and St George's Road.
  - Unsightly grassed area at Telford Central train station
  - Cessation of work replacing grass verges with tarmac in Donnington.
  - Central Hall, Donnington
  - The restructuring of Telford & Wrekin Council
  - Signs for the Railfreight terminal

Councillor Mrs E A Clare then left the meeting prior to discussing planning applications.

## 5. Planning Applications

The Council discussed the following planning applications received electronically for the first time and demonstrated to those present how this Parish Council manages the new system:

a. TWC2010/0006

Mr I Sadler, Talbot Centre, Hillside East, Lilleshall, Shropshire.

Erection of 4no. 10m high floodlights.

**Resolved** – that there is no objection to this application. However, the Parish Council would recommend that the light columns are of a colour that would blend them in to the surrounding landscape e.g. powder coated in green. The Council has also sought information regarding the type of lighting to be used from Mr G Little (Telford & Wrekin Lighting Officer) who, after examining the application, stated that there should be no issue of light pollution to neighbours if the floodlights are installed correctly. Members were also concerned as to who would ultimately be responsible for the maintenance of the lights after installation and the management of switching them on and off.

b. TWC2010/0029

Mr P Cordell, 1 Landy Close, Donnington, Telford, Shropshire.

Formation of 3no. parking bays and re-routing of existing footpath.

**Resolved** – that there is no objection to this application.
